Multifaceted, comprehensive action is required to effectively address family harm and intimate partner violence in Aotearoa. Partnerships between government, tangata whenua, advocates, agencies, researchers, media and communities is needed. It's a long-term investment supported by an overall strategic framework of policies, infrastructure and communities, people just like you!

1 in 3 (35%) of NZ women experienced physical and/or sexual intimate partner violence (IPV) in their lifetime, when psychological or emotional abuse is included, 55% experienced IPV in their

lifetime. (Fanslow and Robinson, 2011)

You may feel there is little you can do to effect the change to halt the cycle of violence in Aotearoa. You are already doing it, we all just need to do more!

The Christchurch Aunties is committed to our vision of a Canterbury where all women and children who have been exposed to abuse are safe, well supported and resourced, through our collaborating agencies.


