They've also been a great help for our youth, who often don't have stable access to a computer and internet they can depend on. This includes use during our Homework Club sessions.

One of our newest staff members and our social worker do a lot of outreach work, which requires them to do a lot of their work out of office. The outreach work they do consists of going out to different tertiary institutions and presenting to students who need any sort of assistance. The tablets have been a valuable tool in aiding presentations and ensuring that we can capture information from these students on the go.

As of 2023, we are humbled and blessed to continue expanding our staff members to cater towards the educational needs for our rangatahi/autalavou/youth. 5 new staff members are being added to our organisation, so we are seeking any technological assistance where possible.







These staff members do amazing mahi with the primary school level children at multiple schools by teaching them Kapa Haka and a variety of Pacific Island (Samoan/Tongan/Cook Island) traditional dance forms and techniques. This work happens all year round and the children from these schools often get to showcase all their hard work throughout the year at an end of year concert held by the schools.
